USACE Regulatory Authorities

- **Section 404 of Clean Water Act** - Discharges of dredged or fill material into wetlands and others waters of the United States
- **Section 10 of Rivers and Harbors Act** - Any work or structures in, or affecting, navigable waters of the United States
- **Section 103 of Marine Protection, Research and Sanctuaries Act** – Ocean disposal of dredged material
- **Our Workload:** (1) jurisdictional determinations; (2) evaluate proposed mitigation banks; (3) evaluate permit applications; (3) write NEPA documents; (4) enforcement actions



Useful Information for Regulatory

- **Identification of sites with potential for developing mitigation banks**
- **Standardized approach and methods for monitoring streams and wetlands within mitigation banks**
- **Techniques and data for evaluating cumulative impacts within 8- digit HUCs**
- **Innovative strategies for managing disposal of dredged material**
- **Studies and data needed to determine if a non-RPW and adjacent wetlands are significant (i.e, significant nexus determination from Rapanos and McWane Decisions)**
