






CRD Organizational Chart



Marsh and Shore Management


- ☐ Manages uses of Georgia's coastal marshlands, sand-sharing systems, and tidal water bottoms.
 - ☐ Permitting
 - ☐ Use of State lands (Revocable License)
 - ☐ Intergovernmental coordination
- ☐ Uses research to support regulatory decision-making:
 - ☐ Dock shading study (C. Alexander)
 - ☐ Marsh wrack study (M. Alber)


